

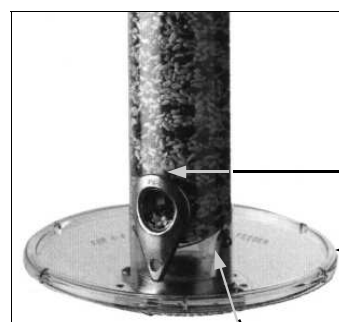

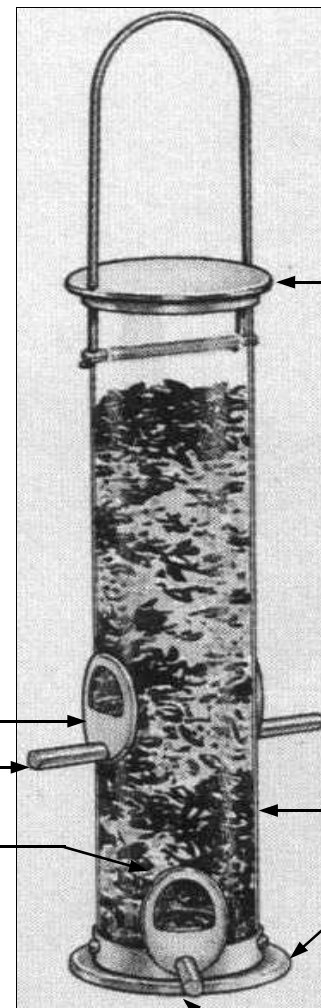
Selecting Tube Bird Feeders

Tips on Selecting Tube Bird Feeders

- Look for steel perches vs plastic/wood
- Birds feet will not stick to steel perches as their feet are made of “fingernail” like material.
- Birds will not get cold on steel perches as their blood flow is reduced to their feet in cold weather, thus heat loss is minimal
- How many perches does it have?
- Is there a seed diverter in the bottom?
- Does it have a hanger and/or pole mount?
- Larger diameter tube will hold more seed.
- Check the tube’s plastic thickness and quality.
- Is there a warranty?
- Metal top and bottom are more durable than plastic
- Is there good drainage?
- Is it easy to fill?
- Can the lid be easily removed?
- Does the port have a rain guard on top to prevent rain from dripping into the tube?
- Can you mount a tray?
- Is it easy to clean?
