Squirrel-Proofing Equipment

There are several ways to protect your seed from squirrels.



1. The closing door style works very well on all types of squirrels. The feeder works better if it has a wider range of adjustment.



The better feeders can be adjusted to prevent larger birds from using the feeder too.

2. Caged feeders will keep gray squirrels from you seed but chipmunks and red squirrels can penetrate the perimeter. These feeders will also help protect feeding birds from predators like hawks and cats.



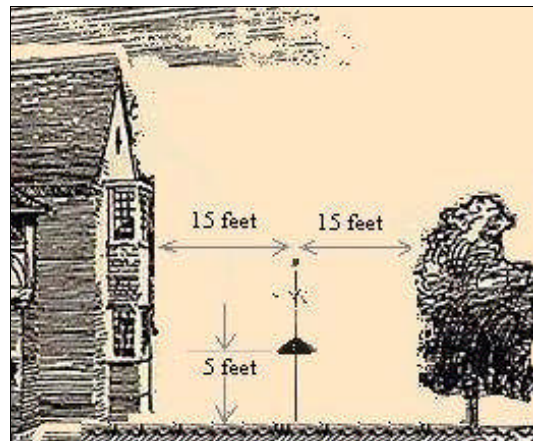
3. Baffle top Feeders. These feeders have built in baffles. The baffle must measure at least 11 inches from the centre to the edge of the baffle to work effectively. The large baffle also helps keep your seed dry.

4. Spinning perch feeder. There is only one spinning perch feeder known as the Yankee Flipper.

It uses a cordless electric motor and it spins the perch when 2 lbs. of weight depresses on the perch. This feeder works well on gray squirrels.

5. Tipping Perch feeders have spring loaded perches or trays. The squirrel simply slides off the feeder as there is nowhere to gasp.

6. Squirrel Baffles come in a variety of shapes and sizes. The distance between the centre and the outer edge must be at least 11 inches to be effective. Use the diagram below to locate a feeder if you use a squirrel baffle.



Locate your feeder 15 feet from any vertical surface and 5 feet from the ground
