## Selecting Hopper Bird Feeders

*A house or gazebo shape will attract more birds than a tower or tube style*

- Get a large roof to keep the seed dry

- Does it have an adequate hanger?

- Is the feeder easy to fill? (ie large opening)

- Does it have a large capacity?

- A wider perching width will attract more birds .

- Will the seed easily flow into the tray from the hopper, there should be a 1/2" minimum for good seed flow.

- A perch separate from the tray will help prevent the spread of diseases.

- Look for good drainage

- Screws are better over staples brads, or other mechanical assembly line fasteners.

- Is there a seed diverter in the bottom to push the seed from the hopper to the feeding area?

- A large tray will provide more feeding area and less spillage
